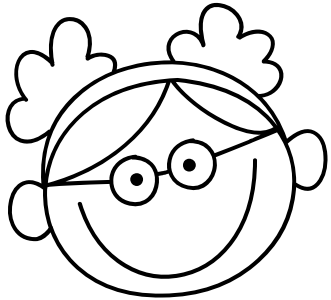


Comparing Adjectives

When comparing two or more things, you use special types of adjectives called comparatives and superlatives.

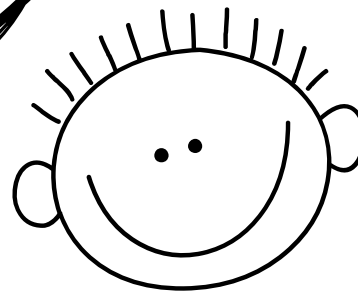
Often, an **ADJECTIVE** just describes one thing.

Raspberries are **SWEET**.



COMPARATIVES are used when you are comparing two things.

Bananas are **SWEETER** than raspberries.



SUPERLATIVES are used when you are comparing three or more things.

Grapes are the **SWEETEST** fruit of all!
