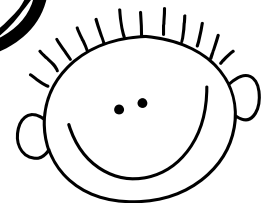
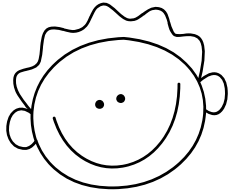


Subordinating Conjunctions

Subordinating conjunctions are at the beginning of a sentence and cause the sentence to have a comma in the middle.



Subordinating Conjunctions

Sometimes we use special conjunctions called **subordinating conjunctions**.

After	After we eat lunch, we will play with slime.
Although	Although I've never tried to ski, I think it would be fun.
As	As soon as the rain stops, we can play basketball.
When	When Mrs. Perkins is sick, we have a substitute teacher.
Before	Before you eat, you should wash your hands.
Until	Until everyone turns in their tests, there is no talking.
Because	Because I have a fractured wrist, I need to sit out for P.E.
If	If you can't go on Saturday, we can go on Sunday.
Since	Since you lost your ball, we will have to play tag.
