

# Homophones and Homographs

Did I say "knight" or was it "night"?  
Did I say "write" or was it "right"?  
It's hard to tell, unless you see how it's spelled  
These are a special kind of word

They're called homophones  
words that sound the same  
but they mean different things  
and they're spelled different ways  
like "made" and "maid"  
Not to be confused with...

Homographs  
words that look the same  
but they're not, cause they're actually two  
different words  
like "ruler" and "ruler"

Think of a phone  
when you think of "homophone"  
'cause it has to do with how the word sounds  
Think of a graph  
when you think of "homograph"  
'cause how the word looks is what that is about

Homophones (they sound the same)  
and homographs (they look the same)  
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Homophones and homographs

Did you mean "fly" or "fly"?  
"Ring" or "ring"?  
"Sign" or "sign"?  
"Spring" or "spring"?  
Since these are homographs  
they look the same  
but they're different words  
that just happen to share a name  
"Scale" and "scale",  
"nail" and "nail" are homographs  
Don't get them confused with...
