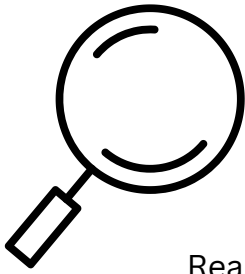

PASSAGE 2

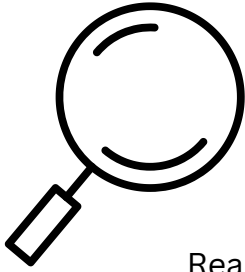
