

Types of Sentences

There are four main types of sentences.

Declarative

Declarative sentences are also called statements. They end in a period and make a statement without too much emotion.

Interrogative

Interrogative sentences are also called questions. They end in a question mark and asks a question.

Imperative

Imperative sentences are also called commands. They end in a period and tell someone or something what to do.

Exclamatory

Exclamatory sentences are also called exclamations. They end in an exclamation point and show lots of emotion.
