

Types of Sentences

You know what a sentence is
and you use them when you write

that there are four different types

Declarative, when something is declared
Interrogative, a question like
"when", "why", or "where"
Imperative, tells somebody what to do
An exclamatory sentence has
an exclamation point (woo-hoo!)

A declarative sentence
is one that makes a statement
It ends with a period like,
"I like to eat bacon."

An interrogative sentence
is one that asks a question
It ends with a question mark like,
"What is your profession?"

An imperative sentence
gives a command
It ends with a period like,
"Come and give me a hand."

An exclamatory sentence
is for emotion or surprise
It ends with an exclamation mark like,
"I can't believe my eyes!"

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
