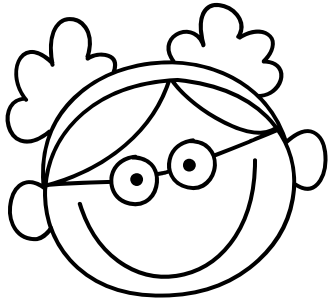


Verb Tenses

A verb can be past, present, or future tense.

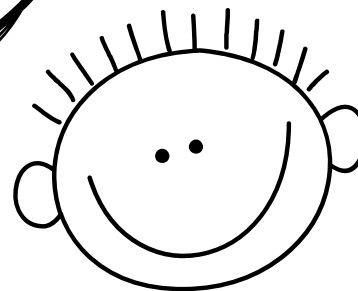
Past tense verbs tell that something has already happened.

I went on a vacation with my family last summer.



Present tense verbs tell that something is happening right now, or happens on an ongoing basis.

I go on vacation with my family every summer.



I will go on a summer vacation someday!

Future tense verbs tell that something will happen, but hasn't happened yet.
